Meeting called to order by Katie Wilking at 4:01 p.m.

May 7th, 2025 Meeting Minutes were unanimously approved.

# **City Council Report**

- -The City has selected a developer for Bonanza Park.
- -The 'General Plan' is being finalized.
- -A study for the future of SR 248 is occurring.

### **Financial Report**

- -Review of financials and cash flow:
  - -Used \$150,000 of the Line of Credit. Another \$250,000 to be used in July.
  - -Potentially able to pay Line of Credit of \$400,000 back by April 2026.

# **Budget for Next Year**

- -Budget Proposal Items Discussed:
  - -5% dues increase
  - -\$25,000 for monument signs
  - -Reserve income 30% of Op dues = \$176k
  - -10% parking increase

- -Items that were not completed in the \$1.6M plan have been added to the budget i.e. monument signs
- -Dean Berrett motioned to recommend ratification of the budget at the July 16th Annual Meeting. Seconded by Jay Niederhauser. Approved unanimously.

# **Master Plan Phase 3 Update**

- -Lot A is planned to be paved next week 6/24 to 6/27.
- -4,600 sq ft of concrete to be poured near Lot A.
- -Leg 3 of sewer work estimated for \$187k, actual \$133k, 90% complete.
  - -Failed the manhole test manholes may be defective/installation issues.
  - -A 2nd manhole testing company has been contacted to test manholes.

### **Executive Director Report**

- -All Board Members have agreed to serve again. In addition to Ryan Osario in 1800 Prospector.
- -Lot J, C, and E need to be seal coated. Tentatively scheduled for July 14th and 15th.
- -Lot I to have patching and striping done this year.
- -Lot D leak repair work begins next week 6/23. Funded by parking stall rental fees.
- -Fuego's had a large water break last week fixed now.
- -TCB Update:
  - Plant material for areas around Lot A is ready, waiting for water to be turned back on.
  - -Brief review of the new irrigation rates beginning July 1st, 2025 possibility of 40-45% reduction of usage. New water irrigation plan will be discussed further with the Executive Committee.
    - -Ask Park City Municipal for any exemptions.
    - -With possible SR 248 construction, Park City Municipal can install a new meter on Kearns to help pay.
- -Salt Box has shown interest to build up may be an encroachment.
- -Annual Meeting is scheduled for July 16th at the Prospector Conference Center. Packets will be mailed this week.

### Other Items

- -Volunteer Prospector garbage clean-up date TBD. Food and prizes!
- -Planning block party to possibly occur in August.
- -Bikes are getting worse at Carriage House need to be thrown away or taken to Christian Center.
