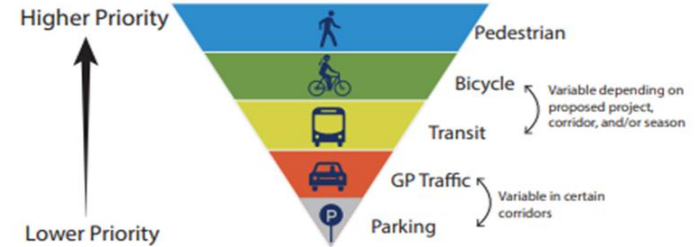

PARK MEADOWS PATHWAYS

Little Kate Road

- **Bi-directional 12-foot multi-use path** on the north side of the road.
- One dedicated vehicle lane in each direction.
- Existing right-of-way that will remain in place.

Monitor Drive

- Two Alternatives
 - **Alternative 1:** Ten-foot dedicated path on the east side plus a five-foot sidewalk on the east side.
 - **Alternative 2:** Twelve-foot multi-use paths for bicyclists and pedestrians to share. This would include a three-foot buffer between the path and roadway.
